- CD's Maturing in Nov -
  - Use of the funds are pushed out at least 6 months with the construction timeline
    -- Voted to roll the funds into another 3 month CD, Passed Unanimous

#### **Tournaments and Scheduling**

- Winter Scheduling underway Nov 1 Bill
  - Looking at bringing in a physical training coach to examine players for balance and strength.
  - Jamie suggested creating a more broad health fair and rent out booths, combine with tournaments?
- Report for Leage software and selecting trial facilitator Jamie
  - Some concerns about letting them own the data and give away member's info. Hefty cut and huge price hike required to cashflow after speedway's cut. Recommended not to pursue

## **Fundraising and Court Development**

- Designing permanent signage for PLI at Peterson Park with Rivers Metals Jamie
  - Found a fabricator, but need a design before getting a price.
  - Need to determine what the sign would say and if we want to pursue a more artistic sign or stay with the city's template
- Police report about the continued vandalism at Ballard Park Joel
  - Nets cut again at Ballard Park, have a police report number, but unlikely to catch anyone without cameras.
- Review City Park drawings/ conversion plans Joel
  - Reviewed drawings and designs for Ballard, Eden, and Densmore. Will assign Court numbers
  - Discussed changing Peterson park back to a 1 paddle rack waiting system
- AED fundraising and implementation by Tracy List Mis.
  - Joel will check with LPR to see if it's a liability issue for storing in the boxes. It's possible Bryan would pay for refurbished units. Regardless, want to have an AED + training at each tournament or organized events. Might need to require RR coordinators AED trained.

### **Communications and Outreach**

- A brief presentation of new functionality identified for the new website Joel
  - What will that look like and what will that improve for PLI.

- Urged the necessity to be able to schedule and accept payment on the new website. Would allow PLI to negotiate additional private courts usage agreements. Centralized location for all locations and payments.
